



Exhibit in the heart of the global nonwovens powerhouse

In 2018, China led the global industry in terms of nonwovens product capacity as well as total output. The latter registered **5.93 million tons**, a year-on-year growth of **5.1%**, and accounting for **over 40%** of global production. China surpassed Europe and North America in 2009. Looking forward, and specifically hygiene, waterproof and filtration nonwovens are expected to maintain growth of **over 10%** per year.


In regards to consumption, it is estimated to reach **5.7 million tons** in China in 2019. This figure accounts for **half** of Asian consumption and **over 20%** of global consumption.

In support of the development of nonwovens production, China has invested heavily in **spunbond**, **spunlace**, **needle-punch** and **air-through production lines**. New lines established in 2018 were 65, 52, 193 and 15 respectively. According to the China Textile Machinery Association, nonwoven equipment imports accounted for USD 98.92 million in 2018, with the top 5 countries / regions being **Germany**, **France**, **Taiwan**, **Japan** and **Italy**. Germany occupies more than 50% of Chinese **nonwoven equipment** imports.


